NYS Board of Regents

- The New York State Regents are responsible for the general supervision of all educational activities within the State, presiding over The University and the New York State Education Department. The Regents are organized into standing committees, subcommittees and work groups whose members and chairs are appointed by the Chancellor. The Board comprises 17 unsalaried members elected by the State Legislature for 5 year terms.
- Our NYS Board of Regents also vote on the approval, renewal, revision and closure of charter schools.
- There is a NYS Board of Regent assigned to each school based on the region they cover. It is important to be in contact with the your Regent each and every year!




Cypress Hills Local Development Corporation (CHLDC) was founded by local residents and merchants in 1983. Cypress Hills had undergone a period of rapid neighborhood change, systemic disinvestment by city government and banks, the flight of long-time residents and the loss of local businesses that devastated the Fulton Street commercial strip. Together, these community members sought to revitalize and improve Cypress Hills through community development. Over the decades, our organization has gone from a one-program organization with an annual budget of \$35,000 to one with six program divisions serving over 11,000 people a year, with a budget of over \$20 million.






