Who are the "Young Doctors?"

The Young Doctors Program is a multipronged, mentoring and education pipeline to health careers. The purpose is to increase African American representation in the field of medicine- via science and health knowledge, exposure to leading clinicians and experts of color in health careers

Start as early in the 9th grade. Remain in the program for 4 years.



Young Doctors DC

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Improving Health in Communities of Color

YDP collaborates with community and faith-based organizations to offer health education and resources to address health inequities.



Achieving Excellence in Education

YDP provides comprehensive multi-tier mentoring, academic support, and scholarships.



Creating Pipeline to Medicine

YDP focuses on Black males interested in becoming doctors and has worked for a decade to establish a pipeline that places Black boys in medical school and doctoral programs.

Summer Academy

The young doctors:

reside on the campus.

take rigorous health classes taught by Howard University medical and doctoral students.

Shadow health professionals at Howard University Hospital and across other healthcare sites in Washington, DC.

Work collaboratively with Summer Health Professions Education Program to establish health education opportunities.



Saturday Academy

The young doctors:

attend Saturday Academy during the academic year.

continue their health education throughout the year.

receive academic support.

Take advantage vast enrichment opportunities.

Community Health

The "young doctors:"

Provide education and outreach in neighborhoods with longstanding inequities, including their own.

Conduct blood pressure screenings

Provide health messaging on COVID-19 and vaccines.
