


Domain 2: Learning Environments



Human Resources

- Final requirement of the Workplace Violence Prevention Law is employee training. We will use NYS DOL PowerPoint presentation, and will create a Certificate of Completion that will be emailed back to Human Resources. This training will be mandatory for all new hires as of 5/1/24.

- Continuing to organize the HR office and update the compliance binders.
- Spoke with our Aflac representative, and we are looking to have him come in during Open Enrollment. Representation and enrollment fell off after COVID.


