

#### Percentage increases for non-instructional staff

- Approval: 2.7% increases for non-instructional staff backdated from August 15 (xcet staff who have already received a promotion and/or title change update
- This increase is supported by the current budget and is equal to the standard increase awarded to teachers for the 2023-24 school year

#### Accountability and Development

#### • Code of Conduct Revisions

- WCHS is submitting updates to our code of conduct to reflect minor changes and policy updates regarding:
  - cell phone use;
  - prohibition of airsoft guns;
  - fire alarm procedures;
  - lockdown expectations and procedures;
  - elevator usage;
  - the school guest policy;
  - classroom removals;
  - detention hours;
  - o alternative learning environment placement;
  - o prohibition of vaping and e-cigarettes;
  - prohibition of gang affiliated attire;
  - physical violence;
  - the school mediation policy;
  - long term suspension/expulsion; and,
  - discipline procedures for students with disabilities.

The above mentioned changes reflect changes that have been made and reviewed by staff and counsel since 2018; however, it requires a formal nonmaterial revision to the state. The changes were made to improve safety, classroom management, and the effectiveness of impartial hearings and related procedures.


