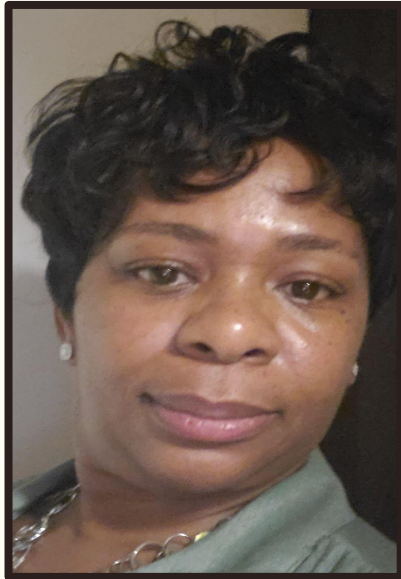

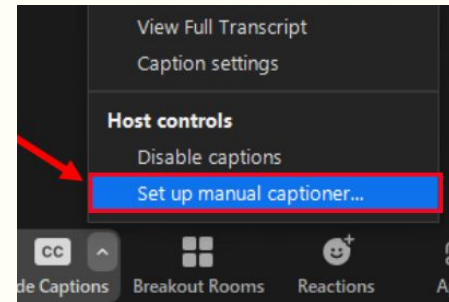


Carter G. Woodson

6. focus on the things you can control.



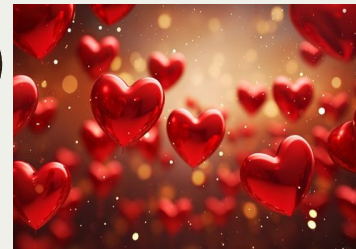

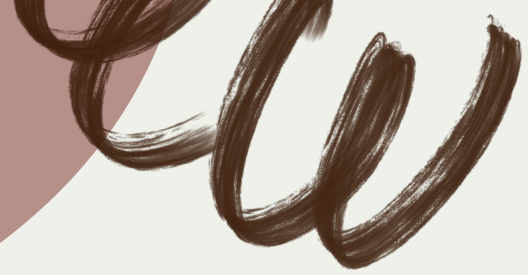
