Zoom Closed Captions in Spanish Directions

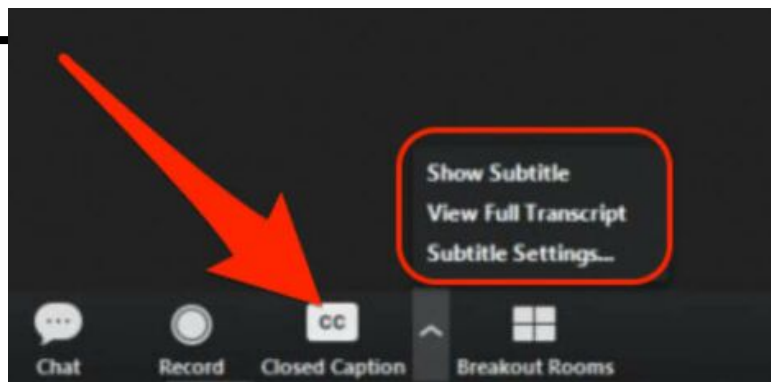
To enable closed captions in Spanish during a Zoom meeting, follow these steps:

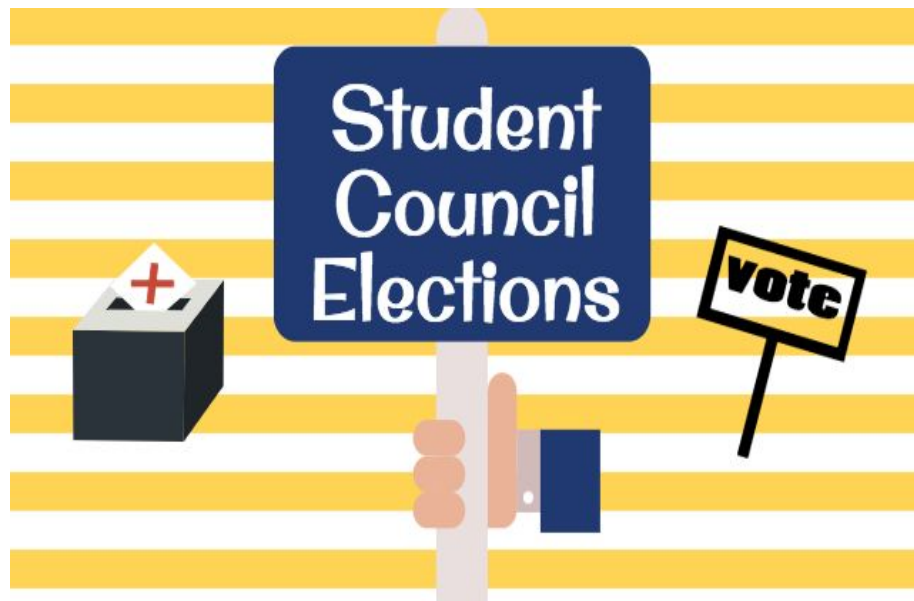

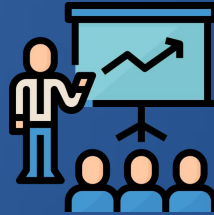

Project-Based Learning

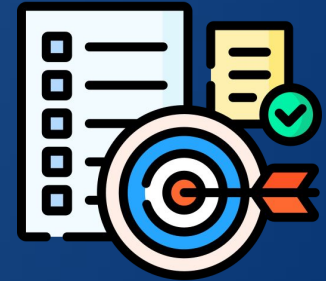
Project-Based Learning: Teens aged 14-15 engage in community projects.

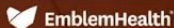
